Saturday March 28, 2009 - Symposium Lectures & Events

9:00am - 10:15am **Niara Isley** - "Facing the Shadow, Embracing the Light: A Personal Story of Trauma, Healing and Transformation" As an experimenter of extraterrestrial abduction/contact and her strange milab-type experiences while in the air force, Niara has gained deep insights into the workings of our world and the roles that different groups of extraterrestrials may be playing in it. Today she works to raise public awareness about the reality of extraterrestrials, to shed light on the machinations of the "shadow government" and re-frame it all in a life-affirming and hope-filled vision of where we may be headed as a species from her own life-long spiritual experience and perspective.

After more than 45 years of researching the UFO phenomenon, he says that a conditioning of belief systems has been orchestrated since 1947 by a manipulative force that is preparing mankind for a near future mysterious scenario. Both Area 51 and Dulce, New Mexico will play a role in that scenario. He will discuss the alternate realities that co-exist alongside the physical images of these locations.

1:00pm - 2:15pm **Victoria Liljenquist** - "Encounters with the Sacred Language of Light, UFOs & Merkabah Vehicles Preparing for the 2nd Earth"

He has traveled the world several times over, seeking adventure and the answers to the mysteries of mankind's past. The eight books of his "Lost Cities" series present fascinating information on the advanced technology and anomalous architecture of our predecessors around the globe. His style is an entertaining blend of personal experience and well-researched fact, bringing to life the legends, history and cultures of the peoples of the world.

4:00pm - 5:15pm **Dr. Michael Salla**. - "Exposing U.S. Government Policy on Extraterrestrial Life" Walter Haut's affidavit concerning events at the 1947 Roswell Crash reveals that U.S. national security officials had secretly approved a range of government policies on extraterrestrial life that would have the highest security classification. This presentation focuses on how select government agencies in the U.S. and elsewhere have secretly implemented public policy over six decades. I examine different ways in which U.S. public policy has been set in terms of resource exchange agreements with extraterrestrial life; illicit funding of black projects concerning extraterrestrial life; suppressing civilian initiatives related to extraterrestrial technologies; and developing strategic national security responses. I will show how these policies have been justified using national security arguments that appear very tenuous at best. I will also discuss exopolitics, as a new disciplinary approach for understanding the development of public policy on extraterrestrial life. Finally, I will discuss the different ways the general public might respond to disclosure of secret U.S. public policies on extraterrestrial life, and what can be done in preparation for such disclosure.
